

More About Rocky Mountain Fever

The program is open to current 4th-11th grade players from any school or community.

Rocky Mountain Fever competitive club teams provide players an opportunity to challenge themselves against other top players regionally and nationally. This helps them improve their own game and prepare them for their next level of basketball at the middle, high school or collegiate level.

High School Teams: Tryouts are held in March and teams begin practicing immediately. Tournament play begins in April and runs through July. Teams play in tournaments throughout Colorado and surrounding states beginning in April. Some teams travel to College Showcase Tournaments in various states such as Texas, Nevada, Nebraska, Oregon and Tennessee.

During the month of June, High School FEVER players return to their high school team to participate in high school team camps so playing on a FEVER team compliments high school basketball team activities.

Middle & Elementary School Teams: Tryouts are held in April and teams begin practice immediately. Tournament play begins in May and runs through June or July. Elementary teams play in tournaments in Northern Colorado. Middle school teams play throughout Colorado and possibly Kansas.
